FIT (Feed in Tariff) – government levy collected from all energy consumers who are supplied by the main energy companies to help fund renewable electricity generation.

Maximum Demand – the maximum half hourly electricity usage recorded by your site during the billing period recorded in Kilo-volt-amperes (kVA) and Kilowatt (kW).

Reactive Power Charge – refers to the difference between the electricity supplied and the electricity converted into useful power.

Data Processing Charge – the charge for collecting the consumption data every 30 minutes and sending this to the supplier to use on the invoices. This is sometimes called the Data Collector charge.

Fixed Charge – this is a daily standing charge for the general maintenance of the meter which applies regardless of whether you use any electricity.

CCL (Climate Change Levy) – a tax on energy delivered to non-domestic users to provide incentive to increase energy efficiency and reduce carbon emissions.

Not always on the invoices

Meter Operator Charges – this contract covers the supply of the meter, maintenance and the necessary telecommunications for sending your consumption data to your energy supplier. This will usually be charged separately to the LASER invoice and charged yearly.

Settlement and Agency – this activity is where distribution companies, suppliers, metering companies and others need to reimburse and recover their costs from one another.

Available Capacity – the maximum amount of electricity your site is permitted to withdraw from the grid at any point in time.
