How to access the framework

Each LASER framework offers a bespoke, OJEU compliant process using service options tailored to suit our customers' requirements. When accessing the chosen framework, the following steps are taken:

- Access Agreement executed between Customer and LASER to allow use of Framework.
- Call-Off Contract put in place with the supplier to confirm supply requirements.
- LOT 1 allows access to additional services via the energy supplier.
- LOT 2 allows access to additional services from a range of suppliers using mini competition.

Over the course of time, additional services may be requested – additional services will require a fresh Call-off Order Form to be signed. Copies of the signed Order Forms will be attached to the Access Agreements to track services accessed through LASER.
